Bone Table

In 2002, Danish designer Kasper Salto introduced the eye-catching Bone Table, named after its sculptural, cross-positioned legs, which seem to support the glass top almost invisibly. The Bone Table is crafted at OneCollection's own workshop in Ringkøbing, Denmark, and is available in solid FSC-certified oak, ash, and walnut.

The Bone Table is being relaunched as both a dining- and conference table with a diameter of 160 cm, as well as a coffee table with a diameter of 100 cm. It is available through all OneCollection and House of Finn Juhl retailers.
