The KS1 Chair is designed by Kasper Salto who has created numerous design solutions for private homes, companies, and public spaces throughout his career. With the KS1 Chair, Kasper Salto wanted to return to the starting point—to begin again with an essential, well-considered chair made with a minimum of materials. Its clear, welcoming expression makes it a natural fit for churches, cultural institutions, and settings where usability and atmosphere go hand in hand

The KS1 Chair is produced at OneCollection’s own workshop in Vejen, Denmark, where House of Finn Juhl’s furniture is also made. It is available in solid FSC-certified oak, beech, and ash, with webbing in black or natural tones made from 90% recycled cotton.
